



## CASTLES OF PERIGORD the Black Périgord

6 days/7 nights



The Black Périgord, named after the black oak forest, largely spread across the valleys of the Vézère and the Dordogne, will seduce you with its centuries old history. Visits of castles and bastides (medieval fortified villages) in varied landscapes will offer riders memorable sights of this area as well as numerous culinary pleasures. Our team is looking forward to guiding you through this authentic journey !

**Program :** *for riders with their own vehicles, late afternoon arrival at the B&B or the hotel. For those without their own transportation, they'll be picked up at the Lalinde's train station also late in the afternoon.*

### Day 1



After breakfast, around 10.30 am, introduction and horses assignment at Château de Bannes (private castle from the 15<sup>th</sup> century). We ride through Lalinde's bastide, then follow the canal towards Mauzac (village on the Dordogne's right bank) where we have a picnic before going to Limeuil an ancient fishing port.

Dinner and overnight in a B&B or a hotel.

### Day 2



After crossing the forest, we have a picnic near the village of St Cyprien, at the Dordogne's edge. In the afternoon, we take the direction of Castelnau la Chapelle in part by a medieval footpath from the castle of Tayac. We leave the horses at night in the Valley of the Céou. Dinner and overnight in a B&B or a hotel.

### Day 3

We ride from the Céou valley to the Dordogne Valley where a picnic is awaiting us at the foot of a windmill, in the Domme bastide. You will enjoy the beautiful sight of the Dordogne Valley from this medieval village before going to Vitrac, the night stop for the horses. We drive to Sarlat, old space well preserved medieval city, for a well preserved dinner and night in B&B or a hotel.

*-In the morning, visit the Castelnaud-la-Chapelle's Castle (12<sup>th</sup> century) and its museum (war in the middle age). The castle offers a magnificent panorama of various areas (Beynac, Marquessac, La Roche Gageac).*

*-Before or after the picnic, visit of Domme, the royal bastide from the 13<sup>th</sup> century.*

### Day 4

**We ride only in the morning** and go through Sarlat before stopping at the Campagnac Castle to have a picnic. Free afternoon to fully enjoy the splendid city of Sarlat. Possibility of a city tour in the afternoon or after dinner, by night.

Dinner and night in B&B or a hotel.

*- Capital of the Black Périgord, city of art and history, Sarlat is considered one of the most beautiful cities of Europe with its magnificent architecture.*



### Day 5



The path we follow to reach Meyrals will give us the chance to see the Puymartin Castle, built during the 15<sup>th</sup> century. Picnic at the foot of Meyrals' Church. In the afternoon we join Audrix which offers a magnificent panorama of the valley of the Vézère. Dinner and night at B&B or a hotel.

- *Visit the Puymartin Castle, first built in the 12<sup>th</sup> century, destroyed in the 14<sup>th</sup> century and then rebuild in the 15<sup>th</sup> century.*

### Day 6



In the morning, we go down to the Vézère Valley to join Limeuil. We ride along the Dordogne River towards Cadouin, where we have a picnic near its abbey (12<sup>th</sup> century). From there, we go through the Bessedes Forest, the most important forest land of the Périgord, and take the time to visit Molière's village, a bastide from the 12<sup>th</sup> century, before going back to the Bannes castle.

Dinner and night at B&B or a hotel.

- *Visit of the 12<sup>th</sup> cent. abbey after lunch.*

### Day 7

Departure or transfer to train stations (Lalinde or Bergerac) after breakfast.

**PRICE:** room for two (6 days/7 nights), single with supplement. This price does not include visits or beverages in hotels and restaurants.
